STATUS OF ORGAN TRANSPLANTATION IN THE COUNTRY

1067 MS. SWATI MALIWAL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of patients officially wait-listed for organ transplants (kidney, liver, heart, lung, pancreas, cornea) during the last five years, State-wise and district-wise, and the number of transplants actually performed;
- (b) the number of patients who died while on waiting lists in the last five years, State-wise and district-wise;
- (c) the number of registered organ donors (living and deceased), with percentage of pledges resulting in post-death donations, year-wise; and
- (d) the details of organ donation awareness campaigns undertaken, with funds allocated and utilised, State-wise?

(a) State/Union Territory (UT) wise number of patients wait-listed for organ transplants (kidney, liver, heart, lung, pancreas) as on 8.12.2025, as reported online by the hospitals in the National Registry Portal of National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisation (NOTTO) is placed at **Annexure I**. The data provided is as per the details provided by the States/UTs in online portal.

The number of transplants actually performed in last five years, as compiled and reported by the States/State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisations (SOTTOs) in their monthly/annual reports submitted offline to NOTTO is placed at **Annexure II**.

At present waiting list of patients requiring corneal transplants is not maintained centrally. The number of corneal transplants (Keratoplasty) performed during the period from year 2020-21 to 2024-25, as compiled and reported by the States to the National Program for Control of Blindness and Visual Impairment is placed at **Annexure III**.

(b) The number of patients who died while on waiting lists in the last five years, State-wise is placed at **Annexure IV**.

(c) The details of the year-wise number of registered organ donors (living and deceased) during the period from year 2020 to year 2024 are given in the table under:

To facilitate citizens to pledge for organ and tissue donation, a dedicated web portal <https://notto.abdm.gov.in> is functional through which till now more than 4.5 lakh Aadhaar verified pledges have been registered since 17th September, 2023

(d) NOTTO along with Regional Organ and Tissue Transplant Organizations (ROTTOs), State Organ and Tissue Transplant Organizations (SOTTOs) organize awareness programs across the country to disseminate information to promote organ and tissue donation engaging with various stakeholders. Various awareness activities like transplant games, poster making, slogan writing, special pledge campaigns are organized regularly. The NOTTO website www.notto.mohfw.gov.in disseminates information about organ and tissue donation including display of IEC Materials. Also, a 24x7 call centre having a toll-free helpline number (1800114770) is functional to provide information, tele-counselling and coordination for organ donation. Dissemination of messages through social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube Channels of NOTTO) is being done on day-to-day basis.

Under NOTP, the budget is provided for augmentation of organ donation and transplantation including for awareness activities. The budgetary allocation under NOTP(including IEC activities) to states/UTs through ROTTos/SOTTOs for the financial years 2021-22 to 2025-26 is placed at **Annexure V**.
