**SUBSIDIES UNDER PMSGBY**

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of claims made for subsidies under the PM Surya Ghar - Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSGMBY) and total subsidies released, State-wise and year-wise since 2024;
- (b) the details of applications made and installations made, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (c) the reasons for low rates of installation in the scheme?

(a) to (c) PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY) is a demand driven scheme for installation of rooftop solar (RTS) systems, wherein all residential consumers in the country having grid connected electricity connection of the local DISCOM can avail the benefits of the scheme by applying on the National Portal of the scheme.

The scheme is progressing well and as on 03.12.2025, a total of 53,54,099 applications have been received on the National Portal and 19,17,698 RTS systems have been installed across the country. Further, a total of Rs 13,793.15 crore has been disbursed as Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to the beneficiaries under the scheme. The state wise and year wise details are given at **Annexure**.
