ASSISTANCE TO STATES FOR DAMAGES DUE TO FLOODS, HEAVY RAINFALL

1198 SHRI MUKUL BALKRISHNA WASNIK:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total losses incurred in the year 2025 due to floods, flash floods, cloudburst, landslides and heavy rainfall as per the assessment of the State Governments, State-wise;
- (b) the details regarding the central teams deputed to assess the damages and their findings, State-wise; and
- (c) details regarding the financial assistance provided for rebuilding of infrastructure including the houses damaged or washed away and compensation to farmers, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a): The Ministry does not centrally maintain the data of damages due to any disasters. However, as per the information received from the various State Governments/UTs, the details of damages caused due to hydrometeorological disasters during the current year (as on 23.11.2025) are at Annexure.
- (b): As on 03.12.2025, a total of 11 Inter-Ministerial Central Teams (IMCTs) have been constituted for the States/Union Territories of Andhra Pradesh,

Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Telangana, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and UT of Jammu & Kashmir, without waiting for the memorandum for on-the-spot assessment of damages caused due to natural calamities during 2025. Based on the report received from the team, further action is taken according to the established procedure.

(c): The financial assistance under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)/
National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) in the wake of natural disasters
is by way of relief and not for compensation of loss as suffered/ claimed.
As per the National Policy on Disaster Management (NPDM), the primary
responsibility for disaster management, including disbursal of relief
assistance on ground level, rests with the State Governments concerned.
However, financial assistance to notified calamity, including landslides
and floods, is provided from SDRF/ NDRF as per established procedure.
The State Government concerned is required to undertake necessary
relief measures in the landslides affected areas out of the SDRF, already
placed with the State Government, as per Government of India norms.

During the current financial year 2025-26 (as on 30th November, 2025), Central Government has released central share of Rs 16118.00 crore to all States under SDRF, in order to support the affected people of the States. The details of the funds allocated and released under SDRF/NDRF to the States are available on Disaster Management, MHA's website i.e. ndmindia.mha.gov.in.
