(a) and (b) The work of 210 km long 6-lane Access Controlled Greenfield Delhi-Dehradun Highway is in advanced stage, with revised scheduled date of completion by January 2026 except 70m service road in Akshardham to Eastern Peripheral Expressway (EPE) Junction section due to pending litigation.
