#### 1295. SHRI LAHAR SINGH SIROYA:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- whether Government has taken steps to protect and conserve heritage monuments across the country
- the details of conservation works undertaken by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) in Karnataka, particularly in Hampi and Pattadakal
- whether Government has increased funding for scientific preservation of heritage sites; (c)
- (d) the manner in which these initiatives would promote tourism and cultural awareness;
- the manner in which Government is ensuring that ASI conservation activities do not (e) hinder tourism promotion and the measures in place to balance the two?

#### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF CULTURE AND TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

- There are 3685 centrally protected monuments/ sites under the jurisdiction of Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) in the country including 506 nos. of (a)
- &
- monuments/sites in Karnataka State. Conservation, preservation and maintenance of these centrally protected monuments and sites is a continuous process and is taken up as per the requirement and availability of resources subject to the National Policy for Conservation. The details of major conservation and preservation works undertaken/carried out in the last three years by ASI in Karnataka including in Hampi and Pattadakal are given in Annexure-I.
- Government provides sufficient funds for scientific preservation of all centrally protected monuments/sites which are under the jurisdiction of ASI.
- (d) ASI organises many cultural programmes to promote awareness about the culture and
- heritage on the occasion of World Heritage Day, World Heritage week. In addition,
- visitor amenities have been provided at centrally protected monuments including all World Heritage and ticketed monuments to facilitate the tourists.
