**SCHEMES TO MITIGATE INCIDENTS OF FARMERS SUICIDE**

1455. SHRI RAMJI LAL SUMAN:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) details of the schemes being run by Government to mitigate incidents of suicide by farmers in the country along with the details of funds allocated and utilized for the same during last three years and the current year till date, year-wise and scheme-wise;
- (b) the number of farmers who committed suicide during 2024 and 2025 till date, Statewise and year-wise;
- (c) whether Government proposes to announce special package for farmers of Uttar Pradesh in view of large scale suicides and devastating rain during current rabi crop season; and
- (d) if so, details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(SHRI RAMNATH THAKUR)

(a): Agriculture is a State subject. Government of India is committed to the farmers welfare and enhancing their overall income and remunerative returns in the agriculture sector. Government of India implements 28 major schemes and programmes to achieve these objectives. These initiatives aim to increase agricultural production, provide remunerative returns, and offer income support to farmers. They are listed at **Annexure I**. The Government has substantially enhanced the budget allocation of Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare(DA&FW) from Rs. 21,933.50 crore BE during 2013-14 to Rs. 1,27,290.16 crore BE during 2025-26. The details of funds allocated and released to States, under various farmer-welfare schemes of Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (DA&FW) during the last three years is given at **Annexure-II**.

(b): The National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) under the Ministry of Home Affairs compiles and disseminates information on suicides in its publication titled 'Accidental Deaths and Suicides in India' (ADSI). The report till 2023 is available on NCRB website (<https://ncrb.gov.in>). The ADSI Report does not specify separate reasons for farmers suicide. Reasons for suicides are wide ranging.

(c) & (d): Ex gratia or relief is provided by State Governments as per their respective provisions and rules. Government of India supports the States through appropriate policy measures and budgetary allocation for schemes for farmers welfare.
