**ESTABLISHMENT OF TRADE FACILITATION CENTRE IN INDO-BHUTAN
BORDER AREAS OF ASSAM**

1490. SHRI RWNGWRA NARZARY:

Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether the Ministry is planning to establish trade facilitation centre in the Indo-Bhutan border areas of the State of Assam to generate livelihood for the people living in border areas;
- (b) whether the Ministry has received proposal from the State Government of Assam for the establishment of Border Haats across the Indo-Bhutan Border in Assam;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) The State Government of Assam has informed that in the Indo-Bhutan border areas of the State of Assam, currently, there are two functional Land Custom Stations, viz., Kawadaisa (Baska District) and Hatisar (Chirang District), and also an Integrated Check Post at Darrangamela (Tamulpur District). Department of Commerce had received a proposal from the State Government of Assam regarding establishment of Border Haats across the Indo-Bhutan border and the same has been duly referred to the Government of Bhutan.
