SHIFTING OF TEXTILE INDUSTRIES FROM JHARKHAND TO ODISHA

1595. SHRI ADITYA PRASAD:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that four major textile companies in the State of Jharkhand are preparing to shift their production units to Odisha;
- (b) if so, the main reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Central Government has received information about the reasons for shifting of industries from Jharkhand; and
- (d) if so, whether the Centre Government has sought any report or clarification from the Government of Jharkhand in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): In order to promote the growth and development of the textile sector across the Country including Jharkhand and to promote investment, the Government is implementing various schemes/initiatives including PM-MITRA, Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP), Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS), Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme, National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM), SAMARTH Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector ATUFS, Silk Samagra-2, National Handloom Development Program (NHDP) and National Handicraft Development Program (NHDP) etc.

However, no information about shifting of production units by four textile companies from Jharkhand to Odisha has been received by the Government.
