AVIATION SAFETY UPGRADES

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the progress of modern landing systems and Air Traffic Control (ATC) automation;
- (b) the number of airports upgraded with satellite-based navigation; and
- (c) whether smaller airports will also be covered for the purpose?

(a) to (c): Presently, more than sixty operational airports in the country are equipped with Instrument Landing System (ILS), 15 airports are equipped with GAGAN based RNP Z (Localizer Performance with Vertical Guidance) procedures and 64 airports are equipped with GPS based Required Navigation Performance (RNP-Y) procedures. State-of-the-art Air Traffic Service Automation Systems have been installed at 44 airports across India to enhance safe and efficient air traffic management. These airports also include several smaller airports.
