PLAN TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF COACHES IN GREEN LINE OF DMRC

1649. SHRI JAVED ALI KHAN:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to increase the minimum number of coaches in green line of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation, (DMRC) from 4 to 8 similar as in other lines of DMRC;
- (b) whether the frequency of trains plying on these routes are also being increased and average waiting time between two trains being reduced from 8-11 minutes to 3-4 minutes; and
- (c) if so, the time by when these measures will be implemented and if not the details of average ridership on green line vis a vis other lines of DMRC justifying the reasons for non implementation?

- (a) to (c): DMRC has informed that 4 coach train are operational on Green Line which is sufficient to meet the traffic requirement. The peak headway in the various sections of Green Line is as under:

Brig. Hoshiar Singh – Mundka	07 min 44 sec
Mundka – Ashok Park Main	03min 52 sec
Ashok Park Main – Inderlok-Kirti Nagar	07min 44sec
