JAL JEEVAN MISSION FOR RURAL SUPPLY IN BENGALURU

1683. SHRI LAHAR SINGH SIROYA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

the status of the State Government's progress in utilizing the Central Grant-in-Aid under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) for rural water supply schemes in the Bengaluru rural and surrounding districts?

The Government of India in partnership with States/UTs is implementing the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to provide functional tap water connections to every rural household (at 55 lpcd, BIS:10500 standard). Water is a State subject and therefore, the primary responsibility for planning and implementing piped water supply schemes to provide tap water to rural households, lies with the respective State/UT.

Under JJM, this Department releases funds to States/UTs only. Further, district-wise fund allocations are made and maintained by States/UTs only and not by this department. The details of Central fund allocated and fund drawn by the State of Karnataka under JJM is as follows: -
