**INCREASING THE DEALER MARGIN OF LPG DISTRIBUTORS**

1728 # SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is considering to review and increase the dealer margin for LPG distributors;
- (b) whether it is a fact that dealer margin have been found to be inadequate compared to the increased operating costs, salaries, transportation and safety equipment expenses over the last few years;
- (c) whether Government has constituted any committee/task force in this regard and if so, its recommendations and the current status of implementation; and
- (d) whether any timeline has been set for increasing dealer margin?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) India imports about 60% of the domestic LPG consumed. Price of LPG in the country is linked to its price in the international market. Government continues to modulate the effective price to consumer for domestic LPG.

As on 01.11.2025, Public Sector OMCs have about 25587 LPG distributors serving the nook and corner of the country. LPG distributors receive distributor commissions for the expenses incurred in the operations of their distributorships and to provide them with reasonable margins to keep their business viable.

The current applicable Domestic LPG Distributors' commission for 14.2 Kg & 5 Kg cylinders effective 04.10.2023 is given below:

Last refixation of Distributors' Commission was done in October, 2023, wherein, while deciding revised Distributors' Commission, it was decided to institute a fresh de-novo study to recommend a revised methodology for determination of Distributors' Commission for domestic LPG. No timeline has been set for revision of Distributors' Commission.
