STATUS OF NATIONAL MONETISATION PIPELINE

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether national assets worth ₹ 3.85 lakh crore out of a targeted amount of ₹ 6 lakh crore were monetised by Government under National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP) during 2021-22 to 2024-25, the details thereof;
- (b) if so, the reasons for not reaching the target; and
- (c) the number of core assets such as roads, railways, power, oil and gas pipelines, telecom, airports, ports, mines and minerals etc. were transferred through long term and perpetual lease, sector-wise details of assets leased out?

(a) to (c) The National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP) included assets with monetisation potential of Rs. 6 lakh crore during the four-year period, against which around Rs. 5.3 lakh crore was achieved which included achievement of Rs 3.87 lakh crore during the first three years and Rs 1.43 lakh crore during the fourth year.

The achievements of the key sectors under NMP (around Rs. lakh crore) include Roads-1.1, Railways-0.3, Power-0.5, Petroleum and Natural Gas-0.4, Coal-2, Shipping-0.2, Mines-0.4 and Urban-0.1.

The detailed aspects such as scope, structure, award of the projects are finalised on case-to-case basis by the respective project sponsoring authorities in accordance with extant guidelines and applicable regulations. Further, the details of the project assets that were monetised under NMP are maintained by the respective project sponsoring authorities.
