IMPLEMENTATION OF HIGH-LEVEL DEMOGRAPHY MISSION

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has formulated any proposal to establish a “High-Level Demography Mission”;
- (b) if so, the Ministry/Department under which this Mission would be operated and the details of its main objectives;
- (c) whether the Mission provides for the formation of a high-level committee/task force for the updated collection and analysis of population data and future demographic planning; and
- (d) if so, the composition and current progress of the said committee?

(a) to (d) Keeping in view the sensitivity of demographic change and its potential national security implications, **the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India** has decided to constitute a temporary High-Level Committee on Demographic Changes. Terms of Reference of the Committee includes to scientifically assess the demographic changes occurring in different parts of the country due to illegal immigration and other abnormal reasons, analyse their causes and recommend appropriate policy, legislative and administrative measures and also to recommend additional and innovative policy, legal, and administrative measures to address these changes.
