Integration of Ayush digital health records with public health system in Odisha

- (a) whether the Ministry plans to integrate Ayush digital health records with the State of Odisha's public health system for monitoring outcomes and community wellness; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b). Ministry of Ayush, under the Ayush Grid initiative, has developed Ayush Hospital Management Information System (AHMIS) for adoption across Ayush facilities throughout the States including Odisha. AHMIS is compliant with the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) and supports standardized diagnostics, service delivery, and data management for monitoring and community wellness. Further, as reported by the State Government, Ayush facilities in Odisha are being onboarded onto the ABDM platform to facilitate the generation of unique Health IDs and digital health records for patients. The Directorate of Ayush, Odisha, is coordinating with the Health & Family Welfare Department to align Ayush dispensaries, hospitals, and wellness centres with the State's digital health infrastructure. Ayush practitioners and staff are also being trained on digital platforms, including the iGOT Karmayogi portal, to enhance the adoption and effective utilisation of digital health record systems.
