(a) & (b): The expansion and modernization of airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by the Airport Operators from time to time depending on the availability of requisite land, commercial viability, socio-economic considerations, and the traffic demand or willingness of airlines to commence/increase operations. The proposal for construction of New Terminal Building (T3) at Bhubaneswar Airport is at a preliminary stage in Airports Authority of India and is subject to Government approvals and requisite regulatory clearances.
