- (a) the details of funds allocated and disbursed under Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) for the last five years, State-wise;
- (b) the technical support extended to the States/UTs under JSY for the last three years;
- (c) the number of women benefitted under this scheme in Tamil Nadu, district/block-wise, categorised into SC, ST and others; and
- (d) whether Government plans to issue clear guidelines on the responsibilities of ASHAs under Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY)?

(a) Details of State/UT-wise approvals under JSY during the last five financial years is placed at **Annexure I**.

(b) Under National Health Mission (NHM), the Ministry provides technical support to the States/UTs through issuance of advisories and guidelines with regular supportive supervisory visits for monitoring, review, and digital monitoring framework.

(c) The district-wise details of number of JSY beneficiaries categorized into SC, ST and Others for the last financial year, as received from the State of Tamil Nadu, is placed at **Annexure II**.

(d) Under Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY), responsibilities of Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHAs) include beneficiaries' identification, facilitate beneficiaries' registration for Antenatal Care (ANC), and facilitating institutional deliveries by mobilising and providing guidance.
