**UPGRADATION OF EXISTING MEDICAL COLLEGES IN TELANGANA**

**1879. SHRI ANIL KUMAR YADAV MANDADI:**

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has identified medical colleges/institutions across the State of Telangana for upgradation/enhancing facilities and infrastructure under any of its Centrally Sponsored Schemes;
- (b) if so, the details of institutions identified for upgradation/enhancing facilities and infrastructure across the State of Telangana, medical colleges/institutions-wise and financial year-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE  
(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)**

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for ‘Strengthening and up-gradation of Govt. Medical Colleges for starting new PG disciplines and Increase of PG seats’. Under the Scheme, financial support is provided for development of infrastructure and procurement of equipment. The fund sharing mechanism between the Centre and State Governments is in the ratio of 90:10 for North Eastern and Special Category States, and 60:40 for others. A total of 511 PG seats have been approved in various government medical colleges in the State of Telangana with an approved cost of Rs. 327.55 Crore in two phases of the above said scheme. The college-wise details of PG seats approved under the scheme are at Annexure.
