- (c) whether families installing solar panels in their courtyards or agricultural fields will be able to avail benefits under this scheme;

(a) to (e) The Government of India launched PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY) in February, 2024, aiming to achieve rooftop solar (RTS) installations in one crore households in the residential sector, across the country including the state of Rajasthan, by FY 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs 75,021 crore.

PMSG: MBY is a demand driven scheme for installation of rooftop solar (RTS) systems, wherein all residential consumers in the country having grid connected electricity connection of the local DISCOM can avail the benefits of the scheme by applying on the National Portal of the scheme. As per the PMSG: MBY guidelines, RTS systems installed on a roof/ terrace/balcony or on top of elevated structures including special RTS installations such as Building Integrated PV (BiPV) systems shall be considered eligible for Central Financial Assistance under the scheme.

As on 09.12.2025, a total of 19,45,758 RTS systems have been installed across the country, benefitting 24,35,196 households. Out of these, 1,08,584 RTS systems have been installed in the state of Rajasthan, benefitting 1,11,521 households in the state.
