Mid-Day Meal Scheme now PM POSHAN

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of schools covered for PM POSHAN during last five years, State-wise;
- (b) the number of average meal days served;
- (c) the number of students actually benefitting versus those enrolled;
- (d) the number of cases of food contamination, food poisoning or substandard meal quality reported and the actions taken against responsible officials or contractors; and
- (e) funds allocated and spent?

(a) to (e): Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) Scheme is one of the foremost rights based Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented in partnership with the States and Union Territories (UTs) for providing one hot cooked and nutritious meal to all children studying in Bal Vatika (just before class-I) and classes I to VIII of Government and Government-aided schools. The overall responsibility for providing hot cooked and nutritious meal to the eligible children lies with the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations. For FY 2025-26, budget allocation for the PM Poshan Scheme is Rs. 12,500 crore by Government of India and the State/ UT share as per the sharing pattern is around Rs. 8,500 crore including additional funds for Honorarium to Cookcum-Helpers and Supplementary Nutrition items. The foodgrain allocation by Government of India is 24.15 lakh MTs which costs around Rs. 9000 crore. Thus overall allocation for the PM Poshan Scheme for FY 2025-26 is more than Rs. 30,000 crore including more than Rs. 21,500 crore made by Government of India.

The State-wise number of schools covered during last five years under the Scheme is at **Annexure**. Under the Scheme, meal is served to children for an average of 220 days per year. Under the Scheme, against the enrolment of 11 crore students on an average 8.5 crore students are availing hot cooked meal on daily basis in more than 10.35 lakh schools in all States/ UTs.

During 2025-26 a total of three (03) cases of food contamination, food poisoning and substandard meal quality were reported. All the children reported ill during these incidents were treated and discharged from hospital and no casualty was reported. The actions in these cases include warning to the concerned NGOs and officers responsible, initiation of departmental proceedings against Principals, Head Masters, suspension and transfer of erring officials and Cook-cum-Helpers, cancellation of contract of suppliers and providing compensation to the beneficiaries if and when required.
