Enrolment and Outcomes on SWAYAM Plus Platform

1950 Shri Narhari Amin:

Will the Minister of *Education* be please to state:

- (a) the total number of students and learners enrolled on the SWAYAM Plus portal during the Financial Year 2025 up to December 2025, since its launch as an industry-aligned MOOC platform;
- (b) the enrolment figures on SWAYAM Plus for the same period, including details relating to enrolments from Tier-2 and Tier-3 regions, State-wise;
- (c) the number of users from the State of Gujarat, particularly from rural and tribal areas, who were enrolled on the platform during the said period, district-wise; and
- (d) whether any assessment is available regarding the number of students who benefited through course completion, credit recognition under the National Credit Framework (NCrF)?

(a) to (d) The Government of India has framed the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 with an aim to provide holistic, multidisciplinary, flexible and student-centric education which promotes lifelong learning and integration of technology in education delivery. NEP also places emphasis on integrating skill development with mainstream education by greater industry-academic linkages, practical, and hands-on learning.

In alignment with the vision of NEP, to enhance employability of the learners, the Ministry of Education, in collaboration with IIT Madras and eminent Industry Partners, has launched the SWAYAM Plus platform in February 2024. The platform offers high-quality skilling and certification programs in partnership with leading industry and academic experts to help students and learners to upskill themselves in line with the industry requirements. Since its inception, the platform has registered an enrolment of over 4.69 lakh learners so far. Of these, more than 12,313 learners are from the state of Gujarat including from rural areas.

So far, more than 31,000 certificates have been issued to the learners in SWAYAM Plus platform. Among these, more than 11,000 certificates were for NCrF-aligned courses.
