- (b) the number of narcotics-related FIRs registered and cases pending, year-wise in Punjab, including conviction and acquittal rates;**
- (c) the number of narcotics-related deaths/overdose fatalities reported annually in Punjab, district-wise;**
- (d) the number of accredited de-addiction and rehabilitation centres, persons admitted and successfully rehabilitated annually; and**
- (e) funds allocated, released, and utilized by Central and State Governments for anti-narcotics enforcement, prevention and rehabilitation, with outcomes achieved?**
