**TRAINING AT CIVIL AVIATION TRAINING COLLEGE**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government has taken adequate steps to provide adequate Training for Communication Navigation Surveillance (CNS) /Air Traffic Management (ATM) Personnel at Civil Aviation Training College (CATC) Allahabad and 4 Regional Training Centers (RTCs) located at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata Airports; and  
(b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of CNS/ATM personnel trained during the last five years?

(a) & (b): The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has taken significant steps to provide comprehensive training for Communication Navigation Surveillance (CNS) and Air Traffic Management (ATM) personnel through the Civil Aviation Training College (CATC) in Allahabad and Regional Training Centers (RTCs) located at major airports in Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, and Kolkata.

The total number of CNS personnel trained during the financial years 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 are 349, 1513, 1262 and 2988 respectively. In the current financial year (2025-26), 1968 CNS personnel have been trained till date.

Similarly, training for ATM personnel has been imparted in various disciplines. The number of ATM personnel trained during the financial years 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25 are 2265, 3535, 3983 and 4034 respectively. In the current financial year (2025-26), 3196 ATM personnel have been trained till date.
