HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION TARGETS

2016. SHRI YERRAM VENKATA SUBBA REDDY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has reduced 2025-26 highway construction target to 10,000 kms from 12,000 kms in 2024-25;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether reducing target delay in connecting key economic centres across the country;
- (d) whether the target of constructing 12,000 kms in 2024-25 has been achieved; and
- (e) if so, details of target set and achieved in the State of Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) The Government in the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has set construction target of 10,000 km for National Highways (NHs) projects for the current financial year 2025-26, considering the present progress of ongoing works and the projects which are to be taken up, subject to fulfilment of pre-construction activities. Construction target of 10,000 km for the current financial year 2025-26 is of the same range as of the previous financial year 2024-25, which was about 10,420 km, against which the achievement was 10,660 km.

The construction target for the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2024-25 was 793 km, against which achievement was 757 km.
