CONVERSION OF NHs INTO FOUR AND SIX LANE

2027. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the length of National Highways (NHs) targeted to be converted into four and six-lane during the next three years and the current financial year, State-wise/UT-wise details including Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the length of NHs converted into four and six-lane so far, State-wise and NH-wise;
- (c) the time by when the remaining work is likely to be completed; and
- (d) the funds allocated by Government to various States for this purpose along with the funds utilised so far, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (c) The Government in Ministry of Road Transport & Highways sets targets annually and not for 3 years for construction of National Highways (NHs) at the beginning of each Financial Year in terms of total length to be constructed, without specifying any lane configuration for it, duly considering present progress of ongoing works and projects for which construction is targeted to be started in that particular financial year. The progress is monitored in terms of length constructed under various projects on aggregated basis for each State/UT.

The State / UT-wise details of construction target set for current financial year, including for the State of Chhattisgarh, along with the total length constructed upto November, 2025 inter-alia including 4 / 6-lane is at Annexure-I. However, out of 4162 km of total length of NHs constructed in the current year, about 1660 km is 4 / 6lane.

(d) The State / UT - wise details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred for development and maintenance of NHs during the current financial year upto October, 2025 is at Annexure-II.
