#### BHARATNET PROJECT IN TAMIL NADU

#### 2094 DR. KANIMOZHI NVN SOMU:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to expand through effective use of BharatNet enabled connectivity to transform 2.5 lakh villages into digital villages;
- (b) if so, the number of villages targeted to be covered in Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (c) the length of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) in kilometer laid in the rural areas of the State, so far; and
- (d) the details of Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) connections commissioned along with the number of Wi-Fi hotspots set up to ensure last-mile connectivity, district-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (DR. PEMMASANI CHANDRA SEKHAR)

- (a) & (b) BharatNet project is being implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all Gram Panchayats (GPs) and villages beyond GPs on demand basis across the country, including Tamil Nadu. The infrastructure created under BharatNet can be utilized by Service Providers to provide broadband services, such as Fibre to the Home (FTTH) connection, Wi-Fi Hotspot, leased line, dark fibre, backhaul to mobile tower, etc. The broadband connectivity enables access to e-health, e-education, e-banking, e-governance, e-commerce, etc.
- (c) As of November, 2025, a total of 55,244 KM (approx.) of Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) has been laid under the BharatNet in Tamil Nadu.
- (d) As per data updated on BharatNet Unified Network Management System (UNMS) portal, 805 FTTH (with Wi-Fi technology enabled) have been provided through BharatNet in Tamil Nadu, as of November, 2025. The details of FTTH connections provided in Tamil Nadu is attached (District-wise) at **Annexure-I**.
