- (a) the progress made in establishing new museums, galleries and experiential spaces in the country, especially in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar;
- (b) the measures taken to modernise existing museums and the support extended to regional museums nationwide, particularly in the said city;
- (c) the impact of national-level cultural events in enhancing public engagement with museums and cultural institutions across the country particularly in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar; and
- (d) the manner in which these museum- related initiatives are expected to promote cultural tourism, strengthen creative economies and expand public access to the country's cultural heritage at national level particularly in the said city?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE AND TOURISM (GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) Ministry of Culture operatives Museum Grant Scheme under which financial assistance is provided for setting up of New Museums, setting up of galleries in museums managed by Central/State Governments, Societies, Autonomous bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, Local bodies, Trusts registered under the Societies Act. The details of new museums established under Museum Grant Scheme for last five years are at **Annexure-I.**

Recently, two new galleries were established in Red Fort, New Delhi i.e., (i) Arms and Armour Gallery and (ii) Air India Art Collection Gallery.

Further, in the past years, Archaeological Survey of India has created and developed several archaeological site museums across the nation. The list of new museums, galleries, experiential spaces developed is enclosed at **Annexure-II**, however, there is no proposal at present for establishing new archaeological site museums, galleries and experiential spaces for especially in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar.

- (b) Archaeological Survey of India annually maintains and periodically upgrades the existing archaeological site museums across the nation.
- (c) and (d): Archaeological Survey of India has enhanced public engagement with cultural institutions through Large-scale exhibitions, observance of World Heritage Day, World Heritage Week, ICOM Intentional Museum Day, and other national events.

These initiatives improve visibility, support outreach activities, and generate wider public interest while showcasing the nation's rich heritage.
