(a) to (d): At present, 538 districts are registered on the Abhinav Pahal Portal, and 34 award-winning projects under the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration are available on the portal. This portal of Department functions as a dissemination platform. The Department promotes awareness and dissemination of innovative practices, through Regional Conferences and monthly National Good Governance Webinars. In regional conferences the good governance practices are presented by concerned officers about the exemplary and innovative projects in public administration to delegates from States/UTs/Districts. In the National Good Governance Webinars two projects awarded under Prime Minister's Awards for excellence in public administration are presented by awardees for knowledge sharing and enabling replication. The objective of the portal is to build a repository of valuable governance practices and provide access to award-winning initiatives, thereby supporting the strengthening of innovative practices. The portal is also updated regularly to include new initiatives ensuring dissemination of good governance practices enabling replication by States/UTs at their own discretion.

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
