TALENT IDENTIFICATION PROGRAMMES FOR PROMOTING POTENTIAL ATHLETES

2238. DR. ASHOK KUMAR MITTAL

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government maintains the record of potential athletes and if so, the year-wise and State-wise details thereof, State-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the steps taken by Government to institutionalize talent identification programmes to avoid biases and ensure inclusivity;
- (c) the details of how Government ensures that schools promote a diverse range of sports promoting talent identification of potential athletes; and
- (d) whether Government has any plans to bridge the gap between talent identification programmes and access to professional coaching and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

(DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

- (a) The details of potential athletes under SAI Sports Promotional Scheme, and Khelo India Scheme, year-wise and State-wise are provided at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) Athletes under Sports Authority of India (SAI) Sports Promotional Schemes are identified in accordance with the approved selection criteria of the schemes. The details of the same are available in the public domain at the website of SAI.

The protocols have been formed for each sport which includes technical experts, sports science experts, prominent athletes, coaches and nominated members of Federations. This ensures objectivity and parity in selections and weeding out.

- (c) & (d) Under Khelo India scheme, strategy to promote a diverse range of sports, facilitate athlete talent identification, and bridge the gap to professional coaching is primarily managed through the given components:

- **Khelo India Centres (KICs):** Establishing one KIC per district where Past Champion Athletes (PCAs) are engaged as coaches to provide professional training at the grassroots level. As part of the capacity building initiatives, Past Champion Athletes (PCAs) have been trained to inculcate correct techniques required for grassroots level training, which shall help in broad-basing the grassroots talent.
- **Khelo India State Centres of Excellence (KISCE):** KISCE strives to establish a world-class sports facility in each State and Union Territory. Setting up world-class facilities in each State/UT to provide advanced coaching and sports science support. The support is given for engaging high quality manpower (coaching, sports science), procuring Sports Science equipment and in periodic assessment of athletes in various parameters.
- **Khelo India Accredited Academies:** KIAAs are to support all best efforts in the country including private academies where in training of Khelo India Athletes is facilitated. Athletes have access to state-of-the-art training facilities, including sports complexes and academies.
