HIGH SPEED RAIL PROJECTS IN HYDERABAD

(a) to (c): Presently, Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) Project(508 Kms) is the only sanctioned project of High Speed Rail in India under execution with technical and financial assistance from Government of Japan.

HSR project are highly capital intensive and any decision for taking up new project is based on many factors such as technical feasibility, financial & economic viability, traffic demand and availability of funds & financing options etc.
