**RURAL ROAD CONNECTIVITY UNDER PMGSY - IV**

2373 Shri Narhari Amin:

Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress made under PMGSY-IV during the financial year 2025, including State wise and UT-wise details of habitations covered and road length sanctioned and constructed;
- (b) the number of all-weather rural roads and bridges constructed in Gujarat during the financial year 2025 under PMGSY-I, II, III and IV, particularly in rural and remote districts; and
- (c) whether the newly constructed roads under PMGSY-IV have improved inter-village connectivity, access to markets, health and education services and overall mobility for rural communities in Gujarat?

(a): The State wise and UT wise details (till 14.12.2025) of road length and habitations sanctioned during the Financial Year 2025 under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana-IV (PMGSY-IV) are as given below:

State	No of roads sanctioned	Length sanctioned (in km)	Habitations sanctioned
Jammu & Kashmir	316	1781.33	429
Chhattisgarh	774	2426.87	780
Uttarakhand	184	1288.198	309

All works are newly sanctioned and at different stages of progress.

(b) & (c): There is no fresh sanction given for any works in this financial year 2025-26 to Gujarat state. All works sanctioned under PMGSY-I and PMGSY-II have already been completed by the State of Gujarat by March 2025. During the current Financial Year 2025-26, 9 roads of 27.66 km length and 12 bridges have been constructed under PMGSY-III.

The PMGSY-IV has been launched in 2024 for construction of 62,500 km of all-weather roads (single lane) to provide connectivity to about 25,000 unconnected habitations of population size 500+ in plains, 250+ in NE & Hill states/UTs, special category areas (Tribal Schedule V, Aspirational Districts/ Blocks, Desert areas) and 100+ in LWE affected districts, as per Census 2011. The implementation period of the scheme is from the Financial Year 2024-25 to 2028-29. The survey work to identify eligible habitations has been completed in Gujarat. No proposals under PMGSY-IV have been received from the State so far.
