FISHING HARBOUR PROJECT AT KULAI IN KARNATAKA

309. SHRI NARAYANA KORAGAPPA:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Bharat Sarkar has approved development of fishing harbor project at Kulai in Karnataka with an estimated cost of nearly ₹ 200 crore under Sagarmala Scheme;
- (b) if so, the details and present status of the project; and
- (c) the anticipated date by when the project is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c) Yes. Department of Fisheries (erstwhile Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries) conveyed administrative approval of Government of India on 23.03.2018 to the proposal of Government of Karnataka for the project “Construction of a fishing harbor at Kulai in Dakshina Kannada District” at a total cost of ₹ 196.51 crore. New Mangalore Port Authority being the implementing agency of the project has informed about the current physical progress of 26% with 31.03.2027 as target date of completion.
