PORT DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN TAMIL NADU

311. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of major and minor port development projects undertaken or proposed in Tamil Nadu under Sagarmala Programme;
- (b) whether Government has taken steps to ensure environmental safeguards and public consultation before undertaking port expansion projects along Tamil Nadu coastline;
- (c) the measures being taken to improve inland waterways connectivity in Tamil Nadu, particularly for cargo transport and rural development;
- (d) whether Government plans to increase funding or collaboration with Tamil Nadu Maritime Board to modernize State ports and support blue economy initiatives; and
- (e) the steps being taken to ensure local employment generation, skill development, and rehabilitation of affected fishing communities in port and coastal development zones of Tamil Nadu?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) Ministry of Ports shipping and Waterways (MoPSW) has sanctioned financial assistance for 24 projects worth \sim Rs.1,343 crore under Sagarmala scheme in the state of Tamil Nadu. The details of projects are at annexure -1.
- (b) As part of project development, the respective project implementing agency is required to prepare social and environment impact assessment reports to ensure due diligence is done to assess the impact of the proposed project on the community and environment.
- (c) There are 10 declared National Waterways (NWs) in the state of Tamil Nadu. As per initial feasibility report, none of the NWs in Tamil Nadu were found feasible for cargo transportation. However, 8 NWs have been indentified by Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) for short distance river cruise tourism.
- (d)& (e) Government of Tamil Nadu has constituted State Maritime and Waterways Transport Committee (SMWTC) to foster collaboration between state and central agencies to ensure the comprehensive development of maritime & waterways transport in the state. Improvement in livelihood of communities in coastal area is undertaken through implementation of projects identified under coastal community development pillar of Sagarmala.
