Expansion plans under PM e-Vidya and Digital India initiatives

337. Smt. Rekha Sharma:

Will the Minister of ***Education*** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry proposes to expand smart classroom coverage in KVs in Haryana under the PM e-Vidya or Digital India initiatives;
- (b) the timelines for such expansion; and
- (c) the expected number of additional classrooms or schools to be brought under the programme?

(a) to (c) Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are managed by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, an autonomous body under the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education, fully funded by Government of India.

Setting up of smart classes in KVs is a continuous process which depends upon various factors such as opening of new schools, addition of higher classes, availability of funds, availability of Internet connectivity etc. There are currently 1205 functional e-classrooms in 35 KVs in the State of Haryana. All KVs utilize existing resources for PM e-Vidya channels or Digital India Initiatives as per the need of the curriculum.
