Off-campus centers of Universities

358 Dr. M. Thambidurai:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) how many proposals have been submitted by universities and institutions across the country for establishing off-campus centres during the last three years;
- (b) out of these proposals, how many have been approved and how many are still pending consideration; and
- (c) the details of approvals granted during the last three years, State-wise and year-wise, including the name of the institution, the location of the off-campus centre and the date of approval?

(a) to (c): The University Grants Commission has informed that during the last three years, 65 proposals have been submitted by universities and institutions for establishment of their off campus centres. As on date, decisions have been taken in respect of 45 proposals. In the last three years, off-campus centres have been established at 10 places in Tamil Nadu, 6 places in Karnataka, 4 in Maharashtra, 3 each in Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Jharkhand, Telangana and Uttarakhand, and 1 each in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chandigarh, Haryana, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Puducherry, Punjab, Rajasthan and Telangana.
