**COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION OF PERSONS ENGAGED IN BEGGING**

**453. SHRI RAJINDER GUPTA**

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Support for Marginalised Individuals for Livelihood and Enterprise (SMILE) Scheme for comprehensive rehabilitation of persons engaged in begging has been expanded in 2025;
- (b) if so, the coverage statistics and outcomes of the programme so far with State-wise/UT-wise details;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of measures taken to ensure coordinated action among State, local bodies and NGOs in this respect; and
- (e) the proposed measures in this respect to make our cities begging-free?

**ANSWER**

**MINISTER OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT**

**(DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR)**

- (a) Yes, Sir. The Support for Marginalised Individuals for Livelihood and Enterprise (SMILE-B) scheme for comprehensive rehabilitation of persons engaged in begging has been expanded in 2025–26 .
- (b) The coverage under SMILE-B has been expanded to include 100 additional cities, taking the total coverage to 181 cities across 32 States/UTs. Since inception of the scheme, a total of 25,698 persons have been identified out of which 7,330 persons have been rehabilitatedState/UT-wise details regarding coverage of scheme and number of persons identified and rehabilitated are enclosed at **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II**.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (a) and (b).
- (d) & (e) The Ministry works in coordination for effective implementation of the Scheme through regular consultations and meetings with State/UT Governments, Urban Local Bodies and Implementing Agencies. The Nodal officers for the implementation of the SMILE -B scheme are nominated by the District Administration where the city is located and all efforts are made to bring in convergence with relevant Central and State welfare schemes within a structured system of reporting on identification, mobilisation, and rehabilitation activities. Further, the Ministry has taken measures to strengthen convergence-based rehabilitation, enhance livelihood and skill-development support for persons engaged in begging, improve monitoring and evaluation mechanisms, and intensify IEC and community-mobilisation efforts with the objective of making the cities begging-free.
