PM-SYM SCHEME IN TAMIL NADU

565. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-Dhan (PM-SYM) scheme in Tamil Nadu, including the number of beneficiaries enrolled in the State, so far;**
- (b) the steps taken to raise awareness about the PM-SYM scheme among the unorganized workers in that State;**
- (c) the details of financial assistance provided to beneficiaries of that State under the scheme, so far; and**
- (d) the challenges faced in implementation of the scheme in that State, including the issues related to registration and disbursement of benefits and the steps being taken to address those challenges?**

(a) to (d): The number of beneficiary enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) scheme in Tamil Nadu as on 26.11.2025 is 70,110.

The steps taken by the Government for the awareness of this scheme in the country including Tamil Nadu are as follows:

- (i) Holding periodic review meeting with States/ UTs.**
- (ii) Common Services Centres (CSCs) are given an incentive on every eligible person enrolled in PM-SYM.**
- (iii) Launch of new features: Voluntary EXIT, Revival Module, Claim Status, and Account Statement.**

(iv) Extension of revival of dormant accounts from 1 year to 3 years.

(v) Two-way integration of PM-SYM and eShram.

(vi) SMS campaign to create awareness.

(vii) Addressing Chief Secretaries of States regarding enrolment under PM-SYM scheme.

To provide financial assistance under the scheme the Central Government provides monthly pension of Rs. 3000/- after attaining the age of 60 years. The disbursement of pension will start from March, 2039. Under the scheme 50% monthly contribution is payable by the beneficiary and equal matching contribution is paid by the Central Government. The contribution amount ranges from Rs. 55/- to Rs. 200/- depending upon the entry age (18-40 years) of the beneficiary.

It is a contributory scheme, hence long-term financial commitment is required by the beneficiaries.

To address this, awareness campaigns are held from time to time in the States/UTs as detailed above.
