(a) to (c): Government is implementing Mission Karmayogi — the National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building — as a flagship mission for civil services' capacity building with a view to enhance administrative efficiency, support adoption of emerging technologies, and strengthen digital governance in line with the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047. The Programme promotes collaborative governance by onboarding States and UTs onto the iGOT Karmayogi platform, integrating State training institutions, and facilitating joint capacity-building initiatives through competency-based learning and platform-driven interoperability.
