- (c) the details of money spent and revenue generated along with the projected growth in this sector?

India has launched the following number of foreign and domestic satellites in the last 20 years:

Number of Satellites launched

Foreign Satellites	31	398
Domestic Satellites	23	56

(c) M/s. NewSpace India Limited (NSIL), a commercial arm of ISRO got incorporated in the year 2019, and total revenue generated by NSIL through Launch Service (From FY 2019-20 till FY 2024-25) is approximately INR 2572 Crore.

Money spent by NSIL to generate the above revenue from Launch Service (From FY 2019-20 till FY 2024-25) is approximately INR 1985 Crore.

The launch service market has become highly competitive with multiple global players and the NSIL puts its efforts to sustain its share in the global market.
