- (a) whether Airport Authority of India (AAI) has taken any decision regarding constructing new airport at Warrangal at the State of Telangana for which the State Government of Telangana is extending all cooperation including land and money;

- (c) whether AAI has fixed any time frame to operationalize the new airport at Warrangal;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?
