Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Ex-servicemen residing in the State of Karnataka, district-wise;
- (b) whether any region-specific skilling/entrepreneurship support has been provided under the Directorate General Resettlement (DGR) and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has partnered with PSUs/private firms to offer remote work/contract opportunities for veterans in non-metro areas and if so, the details thereof; and (d) whether Government proposes any roadmap to bridge the urban-rural disparity in post-retirement welfare schemes for soldiers and if so, the details thereof?

IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE

- (a) and (b) District-wise details of the number of ex-servicemen residing in Karnataka is enclosed as **Annexure 'A'**. The Directorate General Resettlement (DGR) runs resettlement schemes and skill development training for ex-servicemen, disabled soldiers, widows and their dependents to provide job opportunities based on the region specific skilling/entrepreneurships facilities as well as the demand. Details of skill training/ entrepreneurship support provided in Karnataka by DGR is enclosed as **Annexure 'B'**.
- (c) and (d) Department of Public Enterprises, Ministry of Finance through on Office Memorandum dated 13 September 2018 advised all PSUs to undertake provisioning of security services through Directorate General Resettlement empanelled Security Agencies under the DGR Security Agency Scheme. These security agencies also work in remote areas. Further, DGR's Tech Services Scheme also provides all PSUs, the private sector, Industry and Departments of Central and State Governments technical manpower through the State Ex-Servicemen Corporations. To provide post-retirement employment welfare to ex-servicemen, various schemes/ programmes run by the Government such as Coal Loading and Transportation Scheme, Coal Tipper Attachment Scheme, Security Agency Scheme, Common Service Centres (CSC) Scheme, Village Level Entrepreneurship training, Agriculture training, Management of Company Onward Company Operated (COCO) Outlets, Mother Dairy Milk Booths, Safal Shops, Company Owned Retail Outlet Dealerships and reservation in Central Government Posts provide ex-servicemen an opportunity for post retirement employment pan-India including in rural areas.
