CLOSURE OF MSMEs REGISTERED ON THE UDYAM PORTAL

914. SHRI MOHAMMED NADIMUL HAQUE:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) units registered on the Udyam portal, that have reported closure or discontinuation of operations since, 2020;
- (b) the corresponding number of women-owned MSMEs that have reported closure during this period; and
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any assessment of the reasons for such closures, particularly among women-led enterprises?

ANSWER

(a): A total of 1,20,933 MSMEs deregistered during the period (from 01.07.2020 to 30.11.2025) while total 7,22,32,207 MSMEs registered during the same period. The number of MSMEs shut down as a proportion of the total those which have registered since the revision in the definition on 01.07.2020 is 0.17 %.

(b) & (c): Enterprises de-register on the Udyam portal due to a number of reasons such as change in the company owner, certificate not required, duplicate registration, shut down of enterprises and such other reasons. A total of 24,545 women-owned MSMEs deregistered during the period (from 01.07.2020 to 30.11.2025) while total 2,86,40,007 women-owned MSMEs registered during the same period. The number of MSMEs shut down as a proportion of the total those which have registered since the revision in the definition on 01.07.2020 is 0.08 %.
