Goods and Services Tax collection performance

1204 SHRI A. D. SINGH:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the annual growth in GST collections since its introduction;
- (b) whether any proposal exists to rationalize GST rates to reduce the compliance burden on small businesses; and
- (c) the status of compensation payments made to States during the last three financial years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF FINANCE
(SHRI PANKAJ CHAUDHARY)

- (a): The annual growth in GST collections since its introduction i.e. from FY 2017-18 to FY 2025-26 (till Jan, 26) is given as per **Annexure A**.
- (b): GST Council in its 56th meeting held on 03.09.2025, recommended rationalization of the GST rates on many goods and services with a focus on common-man, labour-intensive industries, farmers and agriculture, health and key drivers of the economy. The existing 4-tiered tax rate structure was rationalised into a citizen-friendly 'Simple Tax' - a 2 rate structure with a Standard Rate of 18% and a Merit Rate of 5%. A special de-merit rate of 40% for a select few goods and services has also been prescribed.
- (c) The details of GST Compensation released during the last three Financial Years are as per **Annexure B**.
