- (b) the details of permanent posts of faculties increased during the last five years, State-wise and year-wise;
- (c) the details of number of contractual faculties appointed during the last five years, State-wise;
- (d) the details of MBBS and PG seats which went lying vacant during the last five years and the current year, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (e) the details of faculty positions for MBBS and PG medical, lying vacant as on date, State-wise?

(a) to (e) As informed by the National Medical Commission, the year-wise details of the increase in undergraduate and postgraduate seats, as well as vacant seats in medical colleges, are placed at Annexure.

Health is a state subject, and matters relating to the engagement, deployment, and management of human resources, including faculty and contractual staff in medical institutions, fall within the jurisdiction and administrative purview of the respective State Governments.
