PLI SCHEME FOR SPECIALITY STEEL

1752. SMT. SAGARIKA GHOSE:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) quantity of speciality steel created under different categories since the inception of the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme;
- (b) total investments received and utilized during the financial year 2024-25;
- (c) total number of review meetings initiated in the on-going Research and Development (R&D) projects since October 2024; and
- (d) reasons for the foreclosure of the project on energy efficient production of medium carbon ferromanganese in electric arc furnace?

(a)to(d): About 2.4 million tonnes of specialty steel has been produced domestically, and an investment of about ₹ 23,600 crore has been made under the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme up to December, 2025.

Research and Development (R&D) projects are reviewed. Project Review Committee (PRC) takes a decision on projects based on factors including progress, achievability of results, conflict of views between the project stakeholders, if any etc.
