Integration and expansion of AYUSH services

1940 # Dr. Sandeep Kumar Pathak:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the policy and institutional measures taken by Government so far to effectively integrate Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy (AYUSH) medical services into Government hospitals, Primary Health Centers (PHCs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs);
- (b) the number of newly established and upgraded AYUSH hospitals, dispensaries and AYUSH wings established across the country during the last three years, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) whether there is any specific action plan to integrate AYUSH systems with allopathic services under the National Health Mission (NHM); and
- (d) whether any budgetary provisions have been made or time-bound targets have been set, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)**

(a) to (d) Government of India has adopted a strategy of Co-location of Ayush facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs), thus enabling the choice to the patients for different systems of medicines under a single window. The engagement of Ayush doctors/ paramedics and their training is being supported by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare under National Health Mission (NHM), while the support for Ayush infrastructure, equipment/ furniture and medicines is being provided by the Ministry of Ayush under National Ayush Mission (NAM), as shared responsibilities. Mainstreaming of Ayush has been taken up in 13,094 Ayush facilities co-located under NHM (6,206 PHCs, 3,133 CHCs, 472 DHs, 3283 other health facilities) and health care services are being provided to the community. Further, the State/UT Governments may submit suitable proposals for co-location of Ayush units at PHCs/CHCs/DHs under NHM and NAM with in the existing provisions of the guidelines.

Public health being a State subject, the primary responsibility for establishment/upgradation of Ayush hospitals, dispensaries and Ayush wings across the country during the last three years lies with the respective State Government. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of NAM, a total of 102 Integrated Ayush Hospitals (IAHs), 454 Ayush dispensaries have been approved for establishment and 2489 units of Ayush hospitals/ dispensaries have been approved in different parts of the country during the last three years as per the proposals received from States/UTs through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). The State/UT-wise status of approved units for establishment of IAHs, Ayush dispensaries and upgradation of Ayush hospitals /dispensaries during the last three years are furnished at **Annexure -I, II, & III** respectively.
