**IMPLEMENTATION OF U-WIN DIGITAL PLATFORM IN HARYANA**

**2046. SMT. REKHA SHARMA:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the U-WIN digital platform for universal immunization has been implemented in Haryana;
- (b) the impact of this platform on tracking immunization coverage for women and children;
- (c) the steps taken to address digital access gaps in rural and remote areas; and
- (d) whether Government plans to integrate U-WIN with other national digital health platforms?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE  
(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)**

- (a) U-WIN digital platform for universal immunization is implemented nationwide including Haryana.
- (b) U-WIN provides digital records, line-listing of pregnant women and children due for vaccination. These beneficiaries (pregnant women and children) are digitally tracked on the U-WIN portal for vaccination. SMS alerts are sent prior to three days of vaccination for reminding the beneficiaries about their upcoming due dose.
- (c) In rural and remote areas with poor or no internet connectivity vaccination can be done in U-WIN digital platform through offline mode.
- (d) To improve health service delivery U-WIN is presently integrated with Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), POSHAN tracker online and SAFEVAC online platforms.
