PM-SHRI scheme in the Belagavi

2104 **Shri Iranna Kadadi:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of schools selected under the PM-SHRI scheme in the Belagavi Parliamentary constituency;
- (b) the status of the infrastructure upgradation, including smart classrooms and science labs, in these schools;
- (c) the measures taken to introduce vocational education in trades like foundry and textiles in these model schools;
- (d) the details of the funds released for the green school initiatives (solar power, rainwater harvesting); and
- (e) Government's vision to make these schools Centres of Excellence in the region?

ANSWER

(a) Under PM SHRI scheme, as informed by the State of Karnataka, a total of 28 schools have been selected as PM SHRI from Belagavi Parliamentary constituency of Karnataka out of which 21 schools are elementary, 6 schools are secondary and 1 school is senior secondary. The list of schools selected in the Belagavi Parliamentary constituency, as informed by the State of Karnataka is attached as **Annexure**.

(b) As informed by the State of Karnataka, the status of the infrastructure upgradation, including smart classrooms and science labs, in PM SHRI schools from Belagavi Parliamentary constituency is as follows:

(c) The scheme, aligned with NEP 2020, also has a provision to integrate vocational education into the mainstream curriculum at the secondary and senior secondary levels, equipping students with essential skills for the future. There is a provision of setting up of vocational and skill labs by providing tools & equipment, raw materials, trainers, in-service and induction trainings for trainers, hands on training for students, linkages with sector skill councils etc. Students gain hands-on experience through internships with organisation/companies.

As informed by the State of Karnataka, vocational education have been sanctioned in all 7 secondary and senior secondary schools in vocational trades such as Automotive, Electronics and Hardware and IT and IT-enabled services (IT-ITeS).

(d) PM SHRI scheme also aims to develop PM SHRI schools as green schools by incorporating environment friendly aspects such as rainwater harvesting, energy efficient using solar panels and LED lightings, nutrition gardens with natural farming, waste management, plastic-free, water conservation and harvesting, study of traditions/practises related to protection of environment and awareness generation to incorporate an organic lifestyle. These interventions aim to create a sustainable and eco-friendly learning environment in schools across the nation.

As informed by the State of Karnataka, under the green school initiatives, 6 PM SHRI schools have solar power, for which an amount of ₹29.52 lakh has been sanctioned.

(e) In alignment with the National Education Policy, 2020, PM SHRI scheme has a provision to saturate these PM SHRI schools with 21 NEP components such as computer lab/ICT lab/smart classrooms, library with good furniture, internet facility, vocational skill education, guidance and career counselling, fully equipped integrated science lab/physics lab/chemistry lab/biology lab, playground with well-equipped sports facilities, school innovation council, youth and eco club for mission life, Building as Learning Aid (BaLa) features and jaadui pitara for primary school children, 10 bagless days for students, child tracking software for tracking the children attendance, fully functioning handwashing facility and toilets, green school features etc. These PM SHRI schools are to showcase all the initiatives of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, be the exemplar schools, and also offer benchmarking leadership to other schools in the neighbourhood.
