UNUTILIZED LAND IN KERALA OWNED BY POSTAL DEPARTMENT

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of unused lands in Kerala owned by the Postal department and the area (in hectares) of such unutilized acquired or purchased lands in the State; and
- (b) whether any plans are proposed by the Department to construct post Office buildings or lease out such unused lands?

- (a) The number of unused lands in Kerala owned by the Postal department is 134 as on date and area is 13.281 hectares.
- (b) Yes sir. Construction of Post Office buildings on 11 such unused land parcels have been approved. There is no proposal at present to lease out any of these unused lands.
