Will the Minister of **Chemicals and Fertilizers** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that 70 per cent of the consumption of medical devices, surgical supplies and equipment is met through imports;
- (b) if so, the details of goods imported in the last two years;
- (c) whether Government has any proposal to set up medical device parks in the States, particularly in Rajasthan; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): No, Sir. Imports constitute around 60% of the domestic consumption of medical devices. The segment-wise details of imports of medical devices, surgical supplies and equipment during the last two financial years given below:
